Emissions - State Inspection (if required)

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 16-17 include emission test and state inspection.

Engine Compartment

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 18-29 include air filter, engine belts, seals, and oil.

Transmission

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 30-33 include clutch functionality, fluid, and linkages.

Steering & Suspension

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 34-40 include steering column, fluid, seals, and suspension.

Cooling

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 41-46 include cooling system, coolant, water pump, and hoses.

Exhaust

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 47-49 include manifolds, muffler, and tail pipe.

Fuel

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 50-52 include fuel pump, seals, and filter.

Brakes

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 53-57 include brake booster, calipers, linings, ABS, and lines.

Electrical

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 58-70 include alarm, radio, door lock, windows, lights, battery, and defogger.

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 71-99 include dome lights, fog lamps, hazard switch, headlamps, horn, gauges, and various interior features.

Heater & Air Conditioner

Table with 3 columns: Item #, Description, Meets Guidelines, Requires Service. Items 100-108 include A/C belts, clutch, compressor, refrigerant, and fan.

Appearance, Body & Structural

Items 109-150 include moldings, ashtray, carpet, cup holders, door glass, handles, hinges, trim, leather, pedals, frame, fuel door, gear shift, glove box, hood, interior trim, exterior lights, manual seat, body panels, mirrors, sunroof, trunk, vanity mirror, water damage, windshield, wipers, seatbelts, height adjuster, pretensioner, tires, wheels, spare tire, jack, lug nut, interior odors, labels, license plate, sunshade, and valet key.
